7 Competition Rules and Methods

(1) Competition Rules

All events will be conducted in accordance with the competition rules of the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI), or as otherwise specified in this document.

(2) Technical Delegate

- (3) Competition Rule
 - ① Participants may select a maximum of three individual races.
 - ② Team race competition (team sprint) is classified according to the total age of the members.

Male: 135 years of age or younger and 136 years of age or older Female: 95 years of age or younger and 95 years of age or older

③ If the application is made for the completion to be recognised as an official record event, and electronic timing is used in accordance with the rules, the records will be certified.

9 Eligibility

(1) Eligibility

Participants must be registered with a UCI member federation as at 2022 as follows:

[Domestic Participants] Must hold a UCI ID and/or a JCF license with a registration number.

[Overseas Athlete] Must hold a UCI ID number.

(2) Exclusion of eligibility

Athletes who fall under any of the following cannot participate.

- ① Athletes who have participated in the World Championships, Continental Championships (eg: Asian Championship), Olympics (2020 Tokyo Olympics), Regional Games (eg: Asian Games), and World Cup track races (excluding races only for masters) in 2021 and 2022.
- ② In addition, athletes who have participated in a competition listed on the UCI International Calendar in 2021 or 2022(any races that earn UCI points such as professional tour races. Not including Gran Fondo or masters competitions which do not award UCI points).
- 3 Athletes who are members of a team registered with UCI in 2021 or 2022.
- 4 Athletes who are suspended or punished by either UCI or the National Federation affiliated with UCI
 - * Exclusion rules above do not apply to athletes in para sport divisions except for paragraph 2. ②

^{*}No temporary license will be issued.

(3) Necessary procedures

- ① Declare own record of 200 mFTT (flying time trial), 1 km (500 m) TT, 3 km (2 km) IP self-recording, etc.
- ② Declare whether or not you have participated in any track races within 3 years (2019 2021).
 - *As this will be an international competition, in some events there will be many athletes racing at the same time on the track. To ensure the safety of all athletes, we recommend that you gain some experience on the bank of a velodrome by taking part in a track race before the Games.

(4) Para Competition Classes

- ① Japanese nationals with impairments who wish to participate must register with the Japan Cycling Federation before applying for participation. They must also have a designated Sport Class Status.
- ② Overseas nationals with impairments who wish to participate are required to hold the following licenses prior to application and attach copies of licenses in PDF when applying for participation:
 - i)Cycling National License issued by your country's National Federation.
 - ii) Cycling International License required for participating in an international competition (and a designated Sport Class Status)

(5) Para Open Classes

- ① Japanese nationals with impairments who wish to participate must register with the Japan Cycling Federation before applying for participation. Additionally, attach a copy of a Disability Certificate or Medical Certificate in PDF when applying for participation.
- ② Overseas nationals with impairments who wish to participate are required to prepare the following 2 documents prior to application and attach copies in PDF when applying for participation:
 - i) Cycling National License issued by your country's National Federation.
 - ii) Disability Certificate or Medical Certificate

10 Age Requirement

Minimum age is 30 (born on or before 31 December 1992)

* Athletes must compete in the age category to which they belong as of 31 December 2022.

(Example: If an athlete is 39 years of age during the competition period and will be 40 years of age by 31 December 2022, the athlete will be competing in the age category of 40 to 44 years of age.)

11 Medal Ceremony

(1) General Divisions: Medals will be awarded to the first to third-ranked athletes by event and by age category.

(2) Para Cycling Division (Para Competition Classes & Para Open Classes): Medals will be awarded for each para class

12 Registration Fee

- (1) Competition participation fee (including tax and handling fee)
 - * Check <u>World Masters Games 2021 Kansai Participation Terms and Conditions</u> for detail.
 - ① Competition participants (Basic fee: allowed to participate in 5 disciplines)
 - a) Overseas participants: 24,000 yen/person
 (Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
 - b) Domestic participants: 15,000 yen/person
 (Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)
 - ② Persons related to the competition (Basic fee)
 - a) Overseas participants: 14,000 yen/person
 (Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
 - b) Domestic participants: 5,000 yen/person
 (Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)

*When a helper (a person who supports an athlete with impairment participating in a competition) participates in the competition for providing such support, he/she is required neither to apply for participation in the competition nor to pay a registration participation fee (provided, however, that the helper must apply for participation as a competition official when he/she requires a kit for participating in the competition, a transportation pass and others).

- (2) Additional charges (extra fee)
 None
- (3) Rental fee for competition equipment, etc.
 None (Competition equipment will not be rented.)
- * However, if some parts of the equipment (wheel, saddle, handle, etc.) fail to function and become unusable, they may be rented depending on the type of equipment.

13 How to Apply for Participation

Application is made through the entry system on the official website (Entry System) dedicated to the application for the entry to the competition via PC or smartphone.

14 Notes on Participation

- (1) Clothing
 - There are no particular restrictions except that the UCI World Champion jersey is not allowed to be worn.
 - National jerseys and pants may be worn.
 - Athletes shall wear jerseys and pants of a team registered with the NF.
 - Bibs (race numbers) must be visible on athletes at all times.
- (2) Competition equipment, etc.
 - ① Equipment Regulations
 - · No equipment will be provided by the organiser.
 - Each athlete must bring their own usable equipment which is well serviced and maintained in accordance with the rules. Equipment with poor maintenance shall not be used.
 - Equipment used must comply with the competition rules.
 - ② Rules on transportation and storage
 - In principle, each athlete is responsible for their own shipment and safekeeping of equipment.

(3) Insurance

The organiser will subscribe to accident insurance for participants, but this insurance is applicable only to "injuries incurred during the competition in the competition venues" of the "competition participants and persons related to the competition", and does not cover all risks athletes may be exposed to throughout the Games. Participants shall bear the cost of other insurance coverages needed for the period of the Games.

(4) Doping Control

- ① The doping control in accordance with the <u>World Anti-Doping Code</u> and <u>the rules</u> of the <u>International Masters Games Association</u> shall apply to this competition.
- ② Anti-doping activities (doping inspections and anti-doping education activities) shall be conducted in accordance with <u>the rules of the International Masters</u> Games Association.
- ③ Participants are deemed to have agreed to be subject to doping control procedures in accordance with <u>the rules of the International Masters Games Association</u> upon entry to the competition. Participants are advised to check <u>the rules of the International Masters Games Association Rules for more details.</u>
- This competition aims to promote anti-doping activities as an activity to protect clean sports and clean athletes in order to leave various values of sports to the next generation through sports in cooperation with the Japan Anti-Doping Agency.
- (5) Procedure for Bad Weather
 The competition may be interrupted, canceled or postponed in bad weather.

15 Application for Accommodation and Transportation

(1) Accommodation

16 Others

All participants must complete the accreditation process and check-in at the competition venue before participating (competing or getting involved) in a competition.

(1) Games Accreditation

Accreditation services shall be provided at the Opening Village, each Prefectural Masters Village, Center Village, and the Temporary Accreditation Venue. The participant must bring a valid photo identification and complete accreditation process personally by one day before the competition (no exceptions allowed). Furthermore, even when participating in team competitions or as a team, each participant must complete the accreditation process.

Accreditation process can be completed at any of the designated service desks; however, operation hours and dates differ depending on the location.

(2) Competition Venue Check-in
