9 Rules and Method of Competition

(1) Competition Rules

- ① Event 1-8 will be conducted in accordance with the WDSF competition rules.
- ② Event 9-22 will be conducted in accordance with the JDSF competition rules.

- (3) Scoring method: The Skating System shall be used.
- (4) Music playing time and tempo (the tempo is based on WDSF/JDSF Competition rules)
 - ① Event 1-8:

In all rounds of competitions, the music played shall be a minimum of one and a half minutes duration and a maximum of two minutes.

In the Paso Doble the music shall be played at least up to the second highlight and at maximum to the 3rd highlight, provided always that the Chairperson may extend the maximum duration for any dance or dances if in his or her opinion a longer duration is necessary for fair adjudication of that dance or those dances in an event.

2 Event 9-22:

Qualifying and semifinal rounds of competitions, the music played shall be a minimum of one minute and fifteen second minutes duration and a maximum of two minutes.

The final round of competitions, the music played shall be a minimum of one and a half minutes duration and a maximum of two minutes.

Provided always that the Chairperson may extend the maximum duration for any dance or dances if in his or her opinion a longer duration is necessary for fair adjudication of that dance or those dances in an event.

11 Eligibility

- (1) Event 1-8: Participants must be member of WDSF (carry WDSF- e Card(ID-card(MIN))
- (2) Event 9-15: Participants must be members of JDSF Athlete

* Any number of categories can be entered if they meet the eligibility requirements of the dancesports competition guidelines.

12 Age Criteria

Over 30 years old (born on or before December 31,1992)

See "10 Event" for the ages eligible for participation in each category.

* The designated age group is determined based on your age as at 31 December 2022.

13 Medal Ceremony

Awards will be provided by each category. (This may not apply depending on the number of participating couples)

A medal and a diploma will be awarded to the first to third-ranked couples.

Only a diploma will be awarded to the fourth to sixth-ranked couples.

14 Registration Fee

- (1) Competition participation fee (including tax and handling fee)

 - ① Competition participants (Basic fee: allowed to participate in 5 disciplines)
 - a) Overseas participants: 24,000 yen/person
 (Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
 - b) Domestic participants: 15,000 yen/person (Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)
 - ② Persons related to the competition (Basic fee)
 - a) Overseas participants: 14,000 yen/person
 (Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
 - b) Domestic participants: 5,000 yen/person
 (Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)

16 Notes on Participation

(1) Contribution

Event 9-14: JDSF couple must pay JPY500 as the ranking management fees

(2) Insurance

The organizer will subscribe to accident insurance for participants, but this insurance is applicable only to "injuries incurred during the competition in the competition venues" of the "competition participants and persons related to the competition", and does not cover all kinds of risks during the competition. Therefore, all persons taking part in the competition are requested to subscribe to required insurance at own risk and costs.

- (3) Doping Control
 - ① The doping control in accordance with the <u>World Anti-Doping Code</u> and <u>the rules</u> <u>of the International Masters Games Association</u> shall apply to this competition.
 - ② Anti-doping activities (doping inspections and anti-doping education activities) shall be conducted in accordance with <u>the rules of the International Masters</u> <u>Games Association</u>.
 - ③ Participants are deemed to have agreed to be subject to doping control procedures in accordance with <u>the rules of the International Masters Games</u> <u>Association</u> upon entry to the competition. Participants are advised to check <u>the rules of the International Masters Games Association</u> Rules for more details.
 - ④ This competition aims to promote anti-doping activities as an activity to protect clean sports and clean athletes in order to leave various values of sports to the next generation through sports in cooperation with the Japan Anti-Doping Agency.

All participants must complete the accreditation process and check-in at the competition venue before participating (competing or getting involved) in a competition.

(1) Games Accreditation

Accreditation services shall be provided at the Opening Village, each Prefectural Masters Village, Center Village, and the Temporary Accreditation Venue. The participant must bring a valid photo identification and complete accreditation process personally by one day before the competition. (No exception will not be allowed.) Furthermore, even when participating in team competitions or as a team, each participant must complete accreditation process.

Accreditation process can be completed at any of designated service desks; however, operation hours and dates differ depending on the location.
