7 Rules and Method of Competition

(1) Competition Rules

All events will be conducted in accordance with the competition rules of International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF), World Shooting Para Sport (WSPS), and as specified in this document.

In addition, a scope will not be allowed to be used.

SIUS Inc. electric target will be used.

(2) Technical Delegate

- (3) Competition Rule
 - ① A player of each event shoots once (60 or 120 shots) and the ranking will be determined by the scores. No final round will be held.
 - ② A medal will be awarded to the first to third-ranked competitors by each category. Provided, however, the category with less than 3 participants will be

awarded first prize only.

9 Eligibility

- (1) Japanese nationals must be members of the National Rifle Association of Japan.
- (2) Overseas nationals must be a registered member of International Shooting Sports Federation (ISSF) member federations. Please attach the copy of your registration certificate at the time of your application.
- (3) Japanese nationals with impairments who wish to participate must register with the Japan Para Sports Shooting Federation before applying for participation.
- (4) Overseas nationals with impairments who wish to participate must be a registered player classified by World Shooting Para Sport. Relevant PDF documents should be attached at the time of their application.

*SH2 class athletes need to obtain permission for their loaders in advance too.

10 Age Requirement

Minimum age is 30 (born on or before 31 December 1992)

In line with the sport-specific rules, an athlete must compete in their designated age group, with your age determined as at 31 December 2022. For example, if you are 49 during Games time but have turned 50 by 31 December 2022, you would compete in the 50+ age category.

11 Medal Ceremony

The medal ceremony by category will be held at the venue to award medals to the first to third-ranked athletes after the completion of the competition of each event. Provided, however, the categories with less than three participants will be awarded first prize only.

12 Registration Fee

- (1) Competition participation fee (including tax and handling fee)
 - * Check <u>World Masters Games 2021 Kansai Participation Terms and Conditions</u> for detail.
 - ① Competition participants (Basic fee: allowed to participate in 5 disciplines)
 - a) Overseas participants: 24,000 yen/person
 (Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
 - b) Domestic participants: 15,000 yen/person
 (Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)
 - 2 Persons related to the competition (Basic fee)
 - a) Overseas participants: 14,000 yen/person
 (Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
 - b) Domestic participants: 5,000 yen/person
 (Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)

*When a helper (a person who supports an athlete with impairment participating in a competition (including a loader) participates in the competition for providing such support, he/she is required neither to apply for participation in the competition nor to pay a registration participation fee (provided, however, that the helper must apply for participation as a competition official when he/she requires a kit for participating in the competition, a transportation pass and others).

- (2) Additional charges (extra fee)
 - Applied only for overseas nationals only 25,000 yen/person (The Additional charges (extra fee) is necessary for application fee for permit for possession of firearms and swords, application fee for permit for explosive transfer, transfer fee of firearms)
 - The price and kinds of ammunition which are sold in the competition venue will be published once they are determined. Ammunition for air gun will be sold at the venue too. As for the payment, we only accept cash (Japanese Yen).

13 How to Apply for Participation

- (1) How to apply for participation in the competition.
 - Application is made through the entry system on the official website (Entry System) dedicated to the application for the entry to the competition via PC or smartphone.
 - * Check <u>World Masters Games 2021 Kansai Participation Terms and Conditions</u> for detail.
- (2) Application period for participation in the competition
 - a) Overseas participants: By 31 January 2022
 - b) Domestic participants: By 28 February 2022
 - * a) For overseas participants, after sending the application through the entry system, they should create the final entry sheet and submit it before 20 February 2022. The procedure to create and submit the final entry sheet will be published on the official website in January, 2022. Please register the information required for obtaining the gun possession permit in Japan.

14 Notes on Participation

(1) Clothing

The competition rules of the International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) and World Shooting Para Sport (WSPS) shall apply.

- (2) Competition equipment, etc.
 - ① Rules and regulations
 - [Firearms and ammunition]
 - Domestic athletes must prepare firearms and ammunition.
 - Domestic athletes must carry the gun possession permit, the membership card of the National Rifle Association of Japan and shooter notebook.

- Overseas nationals must follow the procedures specified by the organising committee of the Games which include a permit of possession of firearms and importing and exporting their firearm, transfer • storage • purchase of ammunition while they stay in Japan.
- Firearms of overseas nationals need to be imported and exported when they arrive in and depart from a country. They cannot leave their own gun with another person.
- The maximum number of firearms you can bring from abroad is two only. This also applies to those participating in multiple events. It is prohibited to bring extra guns. You cannot bring the firearm other than you have registered on your final entry sheet.
- Ammunitions of overseas nationals are not allowed to import except for ammunition for the air gun. Athletes must purchase ammunitions which are sold at the competition venue. In case athletes import ammunition, it will be discarded at the airport. In this case, participants must bear the fee of discarding. Ammunitions purchased at the venue needs to be used at the venue, and remaining ammunitions will be collected or discarded at the venue. Furthermore, participants are not allowed to bring back ammunitions when departing from Japan.
- The price and kinds of ammunition which are sold in the competition venue will be published once they are determined. Ammunition for the air gun will be sold at the venue too. As for the payment, we only accept cash (Japanese Yen).
- 2 Rules on transportation and storage

[Domestic athletes]

• Each athlete must carry his/her own firearm and ammunition and take special care for transportation, carriage and storage.

[Overseas athletes]

- Oversea nationals must follow the procedures specified by the organising committee of the Games which include a permit of possession of firearms and importing and exporting their firearm, transfer • storage • purchase of ammunition while they stay in Japan.
 - * Due to the procedures, overseas athletes must use the Kansai International Airport (KIX) for arrival in and departure from Japan. Enter to and depart from Japan from other airport is not allowed.
 - * No transportation for athlete. Athletes need to arrange transportation by

themselves between the airport to the venue.

(3) Insurance

The organiser will subscribe to accident insurance for participants, but this insurance is applicable only to "injuries incurred during the competition in the competition venues" of the "competition participants and persons related to the competition", and does not cover all kinds of risks during the competition. Therefore, all persons taking part in the competition are requested to subscribe to required insurance at own risk and costs.

- (4) Doping Control
 - ① The doping control in accordance with the <u>World Anti-Doping Code</u> and <u>the rules</u> <u>of the International Masters Games Association</u> shall apply to this competition.
 - ② Anti-doping activities (doping inspections and anti-doping education activities) shall be conducted in accordance with <u>the rules of the International Masters</u> <u>Games Association</u>.
 - ③ Participants are deemed to have agreed to be subject to doping control procedures in accordance with <u>the rules of the International Masters Games</u> <u>Association</u> upon entry to the competition. Participants are advised to check <u>the rules of the International Masters Games Association</u> Rules for more details.
 - This competition aims to promote anti-doping activities as an activity to protect clean sports and clean athletes in order to leave various values of sports to the next generation through sports in cooperation with the Japan Anti-Doping Agency.
- (5) Procedure for Bad Weather

The completion will be held in light rain. Provided, however, that the competition may be cancelled if the competition chairperson finds it difficult to hold the event due to a disaster, etc.

15 Application for Accommodation and Transportation

16 Others

All participants must complete the accreditation process and check-in at the competition venue before participating (competing or getting involved) in a competition.

(1) Games Accreditation

Accreditation services shall be provided at the Opening Village, each Prefectural Masters Village, Center Village, and the Temporary Accreditation Venue. The participant must bring a valid photo identification and complete accreditation process personally by one day before the competition. (No exception will not be allowed.) Furthermore, even when participating in team competitions or as a team, each participant must complete accreditation process.

Accreditation process can be completed at any of designated service desks; however, operation hours and dates differ depending on the location.

17 Notes on participation for overseas participants

In Japan, gun possession is heavily regulated in laws and provisions. Overseas

nationals must follow the procedures specified by the organizing committee of the Games which include the application entry, enter to and departure from Japan, the gun possession permit required for bringing in and out their own firearm while they stay in Japan, import \cdot export \cdot transport \cdot storage of firearm and purchase of ammunition.

- (1) Application period for the entry and deadline for submitting the final entry sheet After applying through the entry system on the official website (Entry System), you should create the final entry sheet and submit it by 20 February 2022.
 - 1. Application through the entry system Due date: Monday, 31 January 2022
 - 2. Submission of the final entry sheet <u>Due date: Sunday, 20 February 2022</u>
 - The procedure to create and submit the final entry sheet will be published on the official website in January, 2022. Please register the information required for the procedure of the gun possession in Japan.
 - Entry will be canceled if the final entry sheet hasn't been submitted by 20 February 2022.
- (2) How to obtain the gun possession permit in Japan

In order to possess firearm in Japan, you should go through police and custom inspection at airport at the time of your entry to and departure from Japan and clear the procedures for the gun possession permit and import/export.

 Due to the procedural reasons, we will limit the entry/departure period, time, and airport for rifle shooting participants from overseas as follows. Entry to and departure from Japan is not allowed other than specified period, designated time, and designated airport.

Entry period: Sunday, 15 May 2022 – Wednesday, 18 May 2022 Departure period: Saturday, 21 May 2022 – Tuesday, 24 May 2022 Designated time: 9:00 – 18:00 Designated airport: Kansai International Airport (KIX)

- Flights from overseas must be direct flights to Kansai International Airport (KIX).
 (You cannot transit to KIX after arriving to other domestic airports)
- Firearms of overseas nationals need to be imported and exported when they arrive in and depart from a country. They cannot leave their own gun with another person.
- The maximum number of firearms you can bring from abroad is two only. This applies to those who will participate in multiple events. It is prohibited to bring extra

guns. You cannot bring the firearm other than you have registered on your final entry sheet.

- Ammunitions of overseas nationals are not allowed to import except for ammunition for air gun. Athletes must purchase ammunitions which are sold at the competition venue. In case athletes import ammunition, it will be discarded at the airport. In this case, participants must bear the fee of discarding. Ammunitions purchased at the venue needs to be used at the venue, and remaining ammunitions will be collected or discarded at the venue. Furthermore, participants are not allowed to bring back ammunitions when departing from Japan.
- (3) Rules on transportation and storage

Firearm of overseas participants will be, after the inspection at airport immigration, will be transported from Kansai International Airport (KIX) to the venue by the logistic supplier contracted by the organising committee of the Games. The mode of its transportation from the venue to the Kansai International Airport (KIX) and how to return firearms to the participants at the time of their departure from Japan will be published on later date. Gun inspection at Kansai International Airport (KIX) is mandatory at the time of their departure too.

- No transportation for athlete. Athletes need to arrange transportation by themselves between the airport and the venue.
- Firearm of overseas participants will be stored in the gun storage at the competition venue during the competition period. It is not allowed to carry out firearm outside the venue.
