6 Competition Capacity

(1) Team composition

For each team to be confirmed, the team consists of 8 athletes, 2 for substitution, 1 manager, and 1 trainer, and the number of athletes in one team should be under 12. (Managers and trainers are eligible to participate in the events as players.) A mixed team should be composed of a maximum of 12 players, including 4 men and women, 1 man and woman for substitution, one manager and one trainer (the manager and trainer can serve as a player as well.)

(2) Teams

Eight teams for each category of indoor men, indoor women, indoor mixed, outdoor men, outdoor women and outdoor mixed

7 Rules and Method of Competition

(1) Competition Rules

All events will be conducted in accordance with the competition rules of Japan Tug of War Federation or as otherwise specified in this document.

At least 3 matches per team will be played.

9 Eligibility

10 Consideration for persons with impairments who participate in the general category competition.

In this event, consideration shall be taken for participants with impairments in the general category competition. The content of consideration according to the types of impairments is the following:

Persons with hearing impairments

- Making aware of the need for consideration by providing bibs, etc.
 Distribute bibs, etc. to make aware of the type of impairments if requested.
- O Accompaniment of a person to help an athlete with impairments Take care to provide a helper to accompany an athlete with impairments to the competition area.

Persons with intellectual impairments

- Consideration to provide easy-to-understand explanations
 Provide easy-to-understand explanations of the competition rules.
- Making aware of the need for consideration by providing bibs, etc.
 Distribute bibs, etc. to make aware of the type of impairments if requested.
- Accompaniment of a person to help an athlete with impairments
 Take care to provide a helper to accompany an athlete with impairments to the competition area.

11 Age requirement

Minimum age is 25 (born on or before 31 December 1997)

12 Medal Ceremony

The Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to the first, second and third-ranked players by class.

13 Registration Fee

- (1) Competition participation fee (including tax and handling fee)

 - ① Competition participants (Basic fee: allowed to participate in 5 disciplines)
 - a) Overseas participants: 24,000 yen/person
 (Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
 - b) Domestic participants: 15,000 yen/person (Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)
 - ② Persons related to the competition (Basic fee)
 - a) Overseas participants: 14,000 yen/person (Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
 - b) Domestic participants: 5,000 yen/person

(Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)

*When a helper (a person who supports an athlete with impairment participating in a competition) participates in the competition for providing such support, he/she is required neither to apply for participation in the competition nor to pay a registration participation fee (provided, however, that the helper must apply for participation as a competition official when he/she requires a kit for participating in the competition, a transportation pass and others).

14 How to Apply for Participation

Application is made through the entry system on the official website (Entry System) dedicated to the application for the entry to the competition via PC or smartphone.

15 Notes on Participation

- (1) Clothing
 - Competitors must wear standard sports clothing such as shorts, sports shirts and stockings.
 - Protective clothing (anchor protectors) is allowed only for the anchor to prevent an injury.
 - An approval from the person in charge of weight measurement for the wearing of the gear.

(The competition rules Japan Tug of War Federation shall apply.)

- (2) Shoes
 - Indoor shoes should be indoor sports shoes made of materials that do not damage the floor.
 - Outdoor shoes should be such that spikes or needles are not attached to the shoe bottom or the heel.
- (3) Competition equipment, etc. (Indoor)A mat certified by the Japanese Federation must be used.
- (4) Insurance

The organiser will subscribe to accident insurance for participants, but this insurance is applicable only to "injuries incurred during the competition in the competition venues" of the "competition participants and persons related to the competition", and does not cover all kinds of risks during the competition. Therefore, all persons taking part in the competition are requested to subscribe to required insurance at own risk and costs.

- (5) Doping Control
 - ① The doping control in accordance with the <u>World Anti-Doping Code</u> and <u>the</u> <u>rules of the International Masters Games Association</u> shall apply to this competition.
 - ② Anti-doping activities (doping inspections and anti-doping education activities) shall be conducted in accordance with <u>the rules of the International Masters</u> <u>Games Association</u>.
 - ③ Participants are deemed to have agreed to be subject to doping control procedures in accordance with <u>the rules of the International Masters Games</u> <u>Association</u> upon entry to the competition. Participants are advised to check <u>the rules of the International Masters Games Association</u> Rules for more details.
 - ④ This competition aims to promote anti-doping activities as an activity to protect clean sports and clean athletes in order to leave various values of sports to the next generation through sports in cooperation with the Japan Anti-Doping Agency.
- (6) Procedure for Bad WeatherThe competition will be held in light rain (both indoor and outdoor)

17 Others

All participants must complete the accreditation process and check-in at the competition venue before participating (competing or getting involved) in a competition.

(1) Games Accreditation

Accreditation services shall be provided at the Opening Village, each Prefectural Masters Village, Center Village, and the Temporary Accreditation Venue. The participant must bring a valid photo identification and complete accreditation process personally by one day before the competition. (No exception will not be allowed.) Furthermore, even when participating in team competitions or as a team, each participant must complete accreditation process.

Accreditation process can be completed at any of designated service desks; however, operation hours and dates differ depending on the location.

The weight of each participant is measured by the referee using a scale.

 - Women: Only appropriately sized opaque spats or shorts and shirts must be worn for weight measurement.
