- 7 Competition Capacity * Total number of people in both people in general category and hearing impaired (deaf) people category
 - (1) Pairs 400 participants75 pairs of men (150), 75 pairs of women (150), 50 mixed pairs (100)
 - (2) Fours 800 participants

75 men's teams (300), 75 women's teams (300), 50 mixed teams (200)

- * Players may participate in, at most, four categories: Pairs, Mixed Pairs, Fours, and Mixed Fours (common to general and deaf categories).
- * The maximum number of players to be registered in mixed fours shall be 6 players. However the ratio of men/women on the court must be equal (2 men and 2 women) at all times. (The conditions for the ratio of men/women on the court were updated, 1 man and 3 women, and the opposite is not allowed)
- * If a person wishes to participate as an individual without forming a pair or belonging to a team, he/she should apply for "individual participation" upon entry by specifying the position as "attacker/receiver/none in particular." The organiser will determine the pair or team.

8 Rules and Method of Competition

At least 3 matches per team will be played.

- (1) Competition Rules
 - ① Pairs: The FIVB Beach Volleyball Rules and the agreed items of the competition shall apply.
 - ② Fours: Local competition rules and the agreed items of the competition shall apply.
- (2) Technical Delegate

- (3) Competition Rule
 - The minimum number of matches played by each participating team shall be three.
 - 1st league / Ranking tournament (Changes depending on the number of participating teams)
 - 3 sets match [First to win 2 sets and 21 points wins. The tie break is 15 points (this may be altered in bad weather)]
 - Players may serve as a referee or a scorer.
 - The game format may change depending on the number of teams participating.

* The age of the youngest player in the team shall determine the age category.

* The age category entered must be either the actual age category or a younger age category.

10 Eligibility

- (1) For safety reasons, players with hearing impairment (deaf) should participate only in the hearing impairment category. And, non-para player is not allowed to participate in the hearing impairment category.
- (2) Japanese nationals with hearing impairment who wish to participate in the competition may be requested to submit documents related to ①,②or③ as needed.
 - ① A public certificate or doctor's medical certificate proving that the Deaflympics criteria (55 dB) are met. Provided, however, that registration with the Deaf Sports Association is not required.
 - ② Membership of Japan Deaf Volleyball Association
 - ③ Member of All Japan Deaf Federation or affiliated organisations
- (3) Overseas nationals with hearing impairment who wish to participate in the competition may be requested to submit documents related to ① or ② as needed.
 - ① A public certificate or doctor's medical certificate proving that the Deaflympics criteria (55 dB) are met. Provided, however, that registration with the Deaf Sports Association is not required.
 - 2 Registration with the Deaf Sports Association in their own country

11 Age Requirement

Minimum age is 30 (born on or before 31 December 1992)

* your age determined as at 31 December 2022.

- 30+ (Minimum age is 30 : born on or before 31 December 1992)
- 35+ (Minimum age is 35 : born on or before 31 December 1987)
- 40+ (Minimum age is 40 : born on or before 31 December 1982)
- 45+ (Minimum age is 45 : born on or before 31 December 1977)
- 50+ (Minimum age is 50 : born on or before 31 December 1972)
- 55+ (Minimum age is 55 : born on or before 31 December 1967)
- 60+ (Minimum age is 60 : born on or before 31 December 1962)
- 65+ (Minimum age is 65 : born on or before 31 December 1957)
- 70+ (Minimum age is 70 : born on or before 31 December 1952)

In line with the sport-specific rules, an athlete must compete in their designated age group, with your age determined as at 31 December 2022. For example, if you are 39 during Games time but have turned 40 by 31 December 2022, you would compete in the 40+ age category.

12 Medal Ceremony

The medals will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd-ranked teams of each category.

13 Registration Fee

- ① Competition participants (Basic fee: allowed to participate in 5 disciplines)
 - a) Overseas participants: 24,000 yen/person
 (Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
 - b) Domestic participants: 15,000 yen/person (Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)
- ② Persons related to the competition (Basic fee)
 - a) Overseas participants: 14,000 yen/person
 (Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
 - b) Domestic participants: 5,000 yen/person (Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)

*When a helper (a person who supports an athlete with impairment participating in a competition) participates in the competition for providing such support, he/she is required neither to apply for participation in the competition nor to pay a registration participation fee (provided, however, that the helper must apply for participation as a competition official when he/she requires a kit for participating in the competition, a transportation pass and others).

15 Notes on Participation

(1) Clothing

- (2) Competition equipment, etc.
 MIKASA beach volleyball, internationally recognised ball (The organiser will provide the balls.)
- (3) Insurance

The organiser will subscribe to accident insurance for participants, but this insurance is applicable only to "injuries incurred during the competition in the competition venues" of the "competition participants and persons related to the competition", and does not cover all kinds of risks during the competition. Therefore, all persons taking part in the competition are requested to subscribe to required insurance at own risk and costs.

- (4) Doping Control
 - ① The doping control in accordance with the <u>World Anti-Doping Code</u> and <u>the rules of the International Masters Games Association</u> shall apply to this competition.
 - ⁽²⁾ Anti-doping activities (doping inspections and anti-doping education activities) shall be conducted in accordance with <u>the rules of the International Masters</u> <u>Games Association</u>.
 - ③ Participants are deemed to have agreed to be subject to doping control procedures in accordance with <u>the rules of the International Masters Games</u> <u>Association</u> upon entry to the competition. Participants are advised to check <u>the rules of the International Masters Games Association</u> Rules for more details.
 - ④ This competition aims to promote anti-doping activities as an activity to protect clean sports and clean athletes in order to leave various values of sports to the next generation through sports in cooperation with the Japan Anti-Doping Agency.

17 Others

All participants must complete the accreditation process and check-in at the competition venue before participating (competing or getting involved) in a competition.

(1) Games Accreditation

Accreditation services shall be provided at the Opening Village, each Prefectural Masters Village, Center Village, and the Temporary Accreditation Venue. The participant must bring a valid photo identification and complete accreditation process personally by one day before the competition. (No exception will not be allowed.) Furthermore, even when participating in team competitions or as a team, each participant must complete accreditation process.

Accreditation process can be completed at any of designated service desks; however, operation hours and dates differ depending on the location.
